The U.S. government is offering a reward of up to \$7 million for information leading to the arrest of Abubakar Shekau, the shadowy leader of Nigeria's feared Boko Haram militant group



Abubakar Shekau pictured in 2012

- Born: Shekau village in Nigeria's Yobe State. Estimates of his age range from 34 to 43
- Education: Borno College of Legal and Islamic Studies. Shekau's alias, *Darul Tawheed*, implies he is specialist in Tawheed Islamic concept of oneness of Allah
- Languages: Fluent in Hausa, Fulani, Kanuri and Arabic

Boko الم Haram"

- 2002: Boko Haram name means "Western education is forbidden" – founded by *Mohammed Yusuf* to establish Islamic state in northern Nigeria by non-violent means
- 2009: Yusuf killed by Nigerian police. Shekau assumes leadership, yows to strike back against state

Terror campaign: Since Shekau's takeover, more than 4,000 people have been killed, nearly 500,000 displaced and hundreds of schools and government buildings destroyed

2013: Nigerian President **Goodluck Jonathan** declares state of emergency in three states. Military offensive proves ineffective against Boko Haram's guerrilla tactics

May 2014: Shekau gains global headlines with threat to sell more than 200 teenage girls abducted from town of Chibok. China, France, UK and U.S. offer help in hunt for girls



Sharia law
