▲ **Robert the Bruce of Scotland inflicted a crushing defeat against superior English forces under King Edward II at the Battle of Bannockburn**

1994: The world's largest cargo aircraft, the Beluga, was unveiled in Toulouse

1998: Feathered dinosaur fossils found in China supported the theory that birds descended from dinosaurs

2009: A flute over 35,000 years old, thought to be the world's oldest musical instrument, was unearthed in Germany

2010: After 11 hours over three days John Isner finally defeated Nicolas Mahut 70-68 in the final set of the longest match in tennis history
