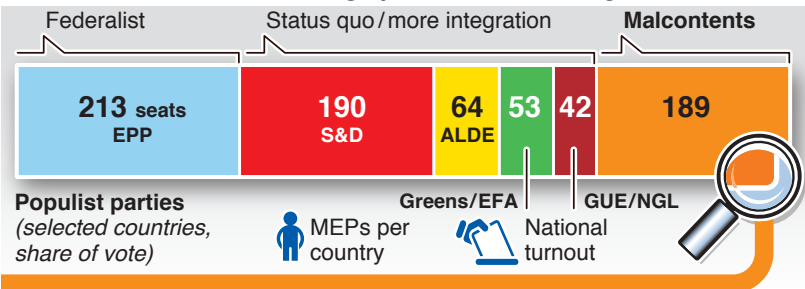


# Malcontent parties in the new parliament
