June 30, 1894

▲ **Tower Bridge, an iconic symbol of London, was officially opened. Two sections bearing the roadway are raised to allow tall-masted ships to pass through**

1834: The U.S. Congress created Indian Territory, encompassing lands west of the Mississippi River, for the use of Native American Indians

1859: Charles Blondin walked across Niagara Falls on a tightrope, watched by 25,000 people

1905: Albert Einstein published an article introducing the concept of special relativity for the first time

1908: A huge explosion, caused by a meteorite, rocked eastern Siberia
