



- Jun 10: Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (ISIS) takes Mosul.
 500 billion Iraqi dinars (\$429 million) looted from central bank
- Jun 11: Al-Qaeda-inspired ISIS enters *Baiji*, home of Iraq's largest oil terminal. *Tikrit* captured. Reports of summary executions of soldiers
- Jun 12: Kurdish Peshmerga forces take *Kirkuk*
- Jun 13: ISIS seizes *Sadiyah*.

 Peshmerga forces clash with ISIS in *Jalula*. Hundreds of U.S. contractors evacuated from *Balad* airbase
- militias, liberate *Muqdadiya*.

 Aircraft carrier *USS H.W. Bush*,
 guided missle destroyer *USS Truxtun*and guided missile cruiser *USS Philippine Sea* moved to Gulf

 Jun 15: ISIS seizes mainly ethnic
- Jun 15: ISIS seizes mainly ethnic Turkmen city of *Tal Afar*. Some staff at U.S. embassy in Baghdad evacuated to Jordan
- Jun 16: U.S. Republicans call for direct dialogue with Iran on security in Iraq. ISIS insurgents push eastwards from *Fallujah*
