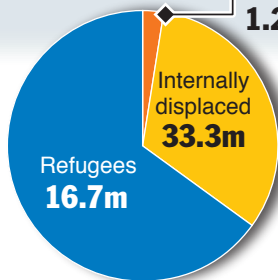


Global refugee figures highest since WW2

More than 50 million people were forcibly uprooted worldwide in 2013, the highest level since the end of World War Two. Conflicts in Syria, central Africa and South Sudan fuelled the sharp increase
