

# Mass trials of Egypt's dissidents

Since a military coup in Egypt in July 2013 more than 1,200 members of the Muslim Brotherhood have been sentenced to death — compared to 185 individuals in 2010, of which four were executed

## Brotherhood supporters sentenced to death



**Feb 25** supporters sentenced to death in absentia for allegedly planning attacks on ships passing through Suez Canal

Morsi supporters sentenced to death, 381 in absentia. 37 death sentences later upheld while 492 commuted to life in prison

Muslim Brotherhood's **Mohamed Badie**, and 682 Brotherhood supporters sentenced to death after eight-minute trial. Badie's and 182 other sentences confirmed June 21

**President Mohamed Morsi:** Held in custody since his ousting from office on July 3, 2013.  
**Mohamed Badie:** Spiritual head of Muslim Brotherhood. Both accused of killing and inciting murder against protesters
