Eduard Shevardnadze



- 1928: Born in Lanchkhuti, Georgia
- 1946: Joins Communist Party, rising through ranks to become Georgia's Party leader in 1972
- 1985-90, 1991: Foreign minister under last Soviet leader, *Mikhail Gorbachev*, overseeing thaw in relations with West before fall of Berlin Wall and collapse of USSR
- 1992: Returns to Georgia, leading newly independent republic out of instability and civil war
- 1995: Elected Georgia's president after surviving assassination attempt
- 2003: Resigns from office amid public protests and claims of corruption during Rose Revolution
- Jul 7, 2014: Shevardnadze, 86, dies after long illness
