▲ The Vatican returned a valuable icon to Russia's Orthodox Church. It disappeared during the Russian Revolution and had hung in the pope's private chapel for 30 years

**1609:** Explorer Henry Hudson discovered Delaware Bay on what is now the northeast seaboard of the U.S.

**1879:** Cetewayo, last of the great Zulu kings, was captured by the British at the end of the Zulu wars

**1994:** Russia withdrew the kopek, a coin worth a hundredth of a rouble

**2009:** Jaycee Lee Dugard was reunited with her family in California 18 years after being kidnapped at age 11 by a convicted sex offender
