September 2, 1838

▲ **Queen Liliuokalani of Hawaii was born. She ruled from 1891-93, and was Hawaii's last sovereign before the Pacific territory was annexed by the U.S. in 1898**

1192: King Richard I of England and the Crusader knights made a treaty with Saladin, ending the Third Crusade

1971: The United Arab Republic reverted to its former name of Egypt

2000: South Korea repatriated 63 spies and guerillas to North Korea as the reconciliation process continued

2004: Malaysia's former deputy prime minister Anwar Ibrahim was released from jail after serving five years on corruption charges
