*September 18, 1914*

▲ **General Paul von Hindenburg was named commander in chief of the German armies on the Eastern Front in World War I following his victory at the Battle of Tannenberg**

**1982:** A massacre in Beirut's Sabra and Shatila Palestinian refugee camps by Christian Lebanese militias, backed by Israeli forces, ended after two days

**1994: Pro-democracy parties dominated Hong Kong's first fully democratic local elections**

**2004:** The IAEA asked Iran to stop its enrichment of uranium

**2007: Over 1,000 Buddhist monks marched peacefully in Myanmar amid anti-government protests**
