1784: The first successful daily newspaper in the United States, the Pennsylvania Packet and Daily Advertiser, was first published

1964: Malta gained independence after 164 years of British rule

1965: The United Nations welcomed three new members, Gambia, Singapore and the Maldives

2010: Over 15,000 people fled their homes after a government offensive against rebels in southern Yemen
