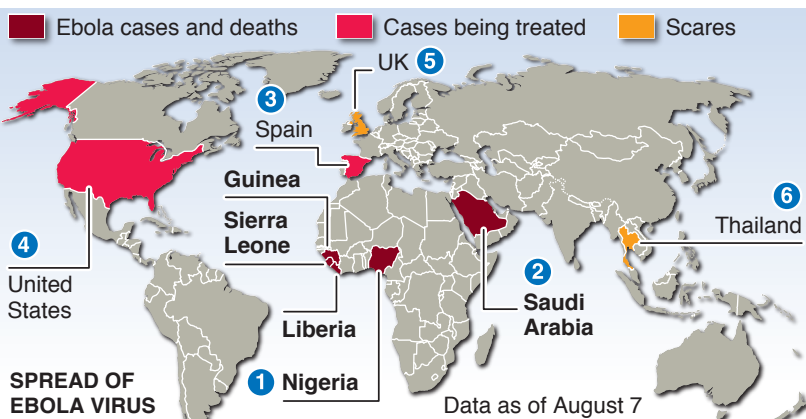


Fears growing over spread of Ebola virus

Concerns about the spread of Ebola are growing, with reports of the first suspected death from the deadly virus outside of West Africa. More than 900 people have now died in the worst Ebola outbreak in history



1 Nigeria: Public health emergency declared as Ebola gains foothold in Lagos, where virus arrived in July carried by Liberian man flying to U.S. via Nigeria. Government has reported second death from Ebola

2 Saudi Arabia: Saudi Ministry of Health says man being treated for Ebola-like symptoms in Jeddah hospital following business trip to Sierra Leone died August 6

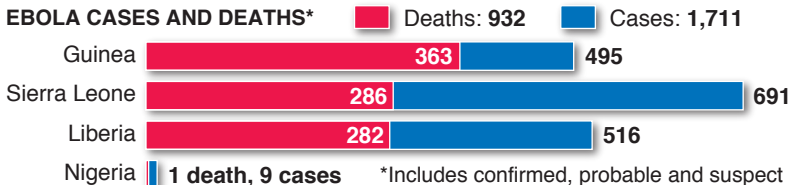
3 Spain: Spanish missionary priest who tested positive for Ebola is in stable condition in Madrid hospital after being evacuated from Liberia

4 United States: Two American aid workers being treated in Atlanta hospital with experimental drug after contracting Ebola in Liberia. Their condition appears to be improving. Patient kept in isolation in New York hospital after trip to West Africa has tested negative for Ebola

5 UK: Health officials monitoring Cardiff woman who fears she may have been exposed to Ebola while visiting western Africa

6 Thailand: 21 tourists being monitored by health officials after arriving from Ebola-affected countries
