

Ukraine may block Russian aid convoy

Ukrainian officials are barring a huge Russian convoy allegedly carrying humanitarian aid from entering eastern Ukraine amid fears that Moscow intends to use it as cover for an invasion



Russia says convoy of over 250 trucks sent in cooperation with International Red Cross. IRC says it has not yet approved mission

Possible route: Access may be granted if convoy enters via government-held border post, accompanied by Red Cross officials
