▲ **Muhammad Ali regained the world heavyweight boxing title by knocking out George Foreman in a match in Zaire, popularly known as the Rumble in the Jungle**

1892: Legendary bodybuilder Charles Atlas was born in Acri, Italy

1894: A patent was obtained for industrial production of the Italian sweet bread, Pandoro

1961: The Soviet Union tested the hydrogen bomb Tsar Bomba, at 50 megatons the largest explosive device ever detonated

1975: Prince Juan Carlos became Spain's acting head of state after General Francisco Franco fell ill
