▲ U.S. boxer George Foreman, aged 47, beat 27-year-old Michael Moorer to regain the world heavyweight title he lost to Muhammad Ali 20 years earlier

**1924:** China's last Manchu emperor, 18-year-old Pu-Yi, was expelled from the Forbidden City

**1928:** Mount Etna erupted, burying the Sicilian village of Mascali

**1994:** Former U.S. president Ronald Reagan revealed that he was suffering from Alzheimer's Disease

**2004:** Chile's army admitted responsibility for human rights violations committed under the dictatorship of Augusto Pinochet
