▲ **Adolphe Sax, musician and instrument maker who invented the saxophone, now a staple feature of both jazz and marching bands, was born**

1965: Cuba and the U.S. formally agreed to begin an airlift for Cubans wanting to go to the United States

1999: Fifty-five percent of Australians voted to retain the British monarch as head of state

2010: Christ the King, the world's biggest statue of Jesus Christ, was completed in Swiebodzin, Poland

2012: U.S. President Barack Obama was re-elected for a second term, defeating Republican Mitt Romney
