▲ The Rotolactor, a rotating milking platform invented by Henry W. Jeffers that could milk 1,680 cows in seven hours, was installed at a dairy in New Jersey

**354:** Early Christian philosopher St Augustine of Hippo, patron saint of brewers and printers, was born

**1994:** Swedes voted in a referendum to join the European Union

**1998:** The IMF announced a £41.5bn aid package to rescue Brazil's ailing economy

**2010:** Burmese opposition leader Aung San Suu Kyi was greeted by a crowd of thousands on her release after 15 years under house arrest
