

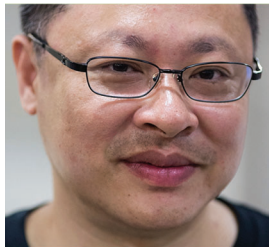
# Who is behind Hong Kong turmoil?

## CHINA GOVERNMENT

■ **National People's Congress**, arbiter of **Basic Law** – under which Hong Kong is governed – said that territory's next leader could be elected in 2017 by universal suffrage

■ But NPC ruled that no more than three candidates – selected by committee of 1,200 largely pro-Beijing members – could stand

## HK GOVERNMENT

■ City's leaders support Beijing's election plan and call protests illegal, but unrest has put government in difficult position between disgruntled citizens and China

■ Government must still discuss Beijing's election ruling and formulate bill to be passed by Hong Kong's legislature

## PROTESTERS

■ Pro-democracy movement **Occupy Central with Love and Peace**, has launched non-violent campaign to demand democratic elections that meet international standards

■ Tens of thousands of supporters of Occupy Central and students are blocking streets, shutting down business hub
