Porsche Cayenne S E-Hybrid SUV: Hybrid electric version of current Cayenne S Hybrid, with addition of 10.8-kWh lithium-ion battery. Electric-only range: Up to **35km**. Zero to 100km/h in **5.4 seconds**

Bentley Mulsanne Speed: Four-door luxury limo packs 400kW (537hp) 6.75-litre twin-turbo V8 to accelerate from 0 to 100km/h in **4.9 seconds**, and continue to **305km/h**. Price: **€324,000**

Jaguar XE: All-new XE S, with 3.0-litre supercharged V6, will power to 100km/h in **4.9 seconds**. Entry price: **€34,700** to XE S at estimated **€64,000**
