

Timeline of Baltic mystery sub drama

→ Oct 3-5: Russian-owned tanker **NS Concord** sails from St Petersburg to Baltic Sea. Ship circles off Stockholm, in international waters, for 16 days

■ Oct 11-16: Warships from Sweden, Denmark, Poland and Netherlands take part in Baltic Sea exercise **Northern Archer**. On Oct 16, Dutch submarine **HNLMS Bruinvis** sails to Tallinn, Estonia

■ Oct 16: Presence of unknown underwater object reported off Stockholm

■ Oct 17: Media reports of encrypted radio transmissions from area

■ Oct 18: Russian research vessel **Professor Logachev** sails from St Petersburg to Baltic Sea



Stockholm archipelago: Search area extends from Möja to Nynäshamn. Civilian vessels told to evacuate area

■ Oct 20: Russia claims mystery vessel could be Dutch sub

■ Oct 21: Jane's Defence Weekly speculates that mystery vessel could be Russian **Losos Class** sub, launched covertly from beneath larger vessel

■ Oct 22: Concord sails in direction of St. Petersburg. Logachev remains in Baltic Sea

Project 865 Piranya Losos Class

Length: 28.2m. Speed: 6.65 knots dived



Crew: 9. Endurance: 10 days. Diving depth: 200m. Armament: 2 mines or 2 torpedoes. Titanium alloy hull reduces effectiveness of enemy mines
