*November 23, 1889*

▲ The world's first "jukebox" was installed in San Francisco. Users listened through earphones to a song played on a coin-operated, wax cylinder phonograph

**1994:** A stampede at Nagpur, India, killed 114 people after police baton-charged a crowd of 50,000 protesters

**1997:** Two New Zealanders won the first ever ocean rowing race, from Tenerife to Barbados, in 42 days

**1999:** U.S. First Lady Hillary Clinton announced she would run for the U.S. Senate for the state of New York

**2009:** The world's largest mass immunisation against yellow fever began, targeting 12 million in Africa
