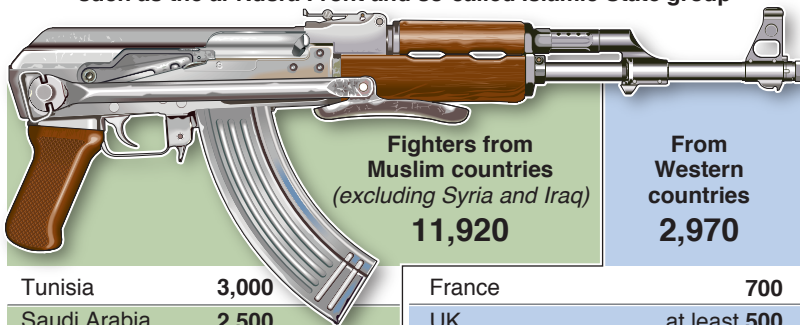


# Foreign fighters in Syria
