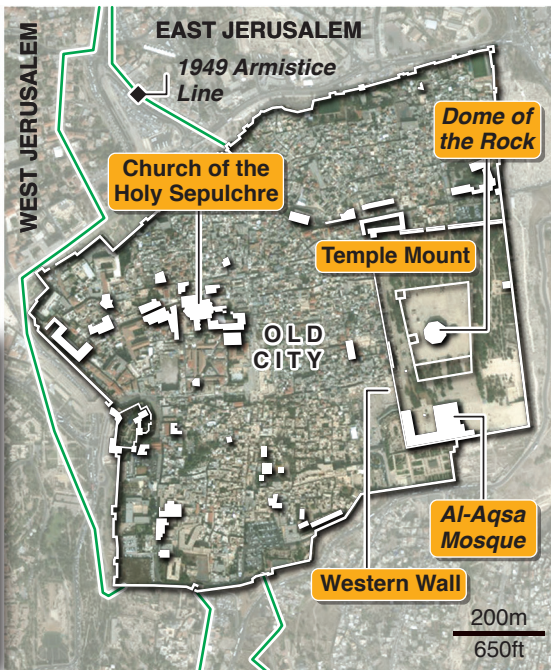
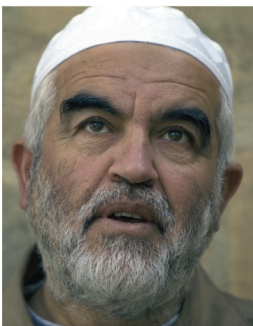


# Palestinian activist Sheikh Raed Salah



■ **1958:** **Raed Salah Abu Shakra** born in Umm al-Fahm

■ **1971:** Joins **Islamic Movement** – ideology is closely related to that of Muslim Brotherhood

■ **1987:** **Hamas** and **Islamic Jihad** emerge during first Palestinian Intifada in West Bank and Gaza Strip

■ **1989-2001:** Serves as mayor of Umm al-Fahm

■ **1996:** Islamic Movement splits into northern and southern branches. Salah heads more extremist northern branch

■ **Sep 2000-Feb 2005:** Al-Aqsa Intifada results in more than 4,000 Palestinian and Israeli fatalities

■ **2003-05:** Salah jailed by Israel for funding Hamas, and of having contact with Iranian intelligence agent

■ **2007:** Calls for third intifada to “free Jerusalem” during protest over Israeli excavation work near al-Aqsa mosque

■ **2009:** Banned from Jerusalem following calls for “religious war” over claims that Israel is seeking takeover of Temple Mount (Haram al-Sharif) and al-Aqsa mosque

■ **May 2010:** Takes part in Gaza **Freedom Flotilla** during which nine Turkish activists are killed by Israeli commandos

■ **Jul:** Jailed for five months over 2007 call for third intifada

■ **Jun 2011-Apr 2012:** Salah is banned and arrested during speaking tour of UK, under British government’s counter-terrorism strategy

■ **2013:** Convicted of inciting violence

■ **Mar 2014:** Jailed for eight months, with three years on probation, for inciting violence in 2007 speech

■ **Nov:** Just days out of prison, Salah makes fiery sermon about conquering Jerusalem and making it Muslim-only capital of Sunni Islamic global caliphate
