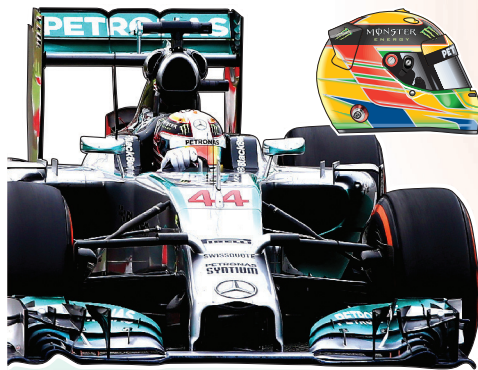


# Hamilton and Rosberg set for final showdown

Lewis Hamilton holds a 17-point advantage over teammate Nico Rosberg ahead of the season finale in Abu Dhabi, with the controversial double points rule, including 50 points for the winner, set to be a deciding factor

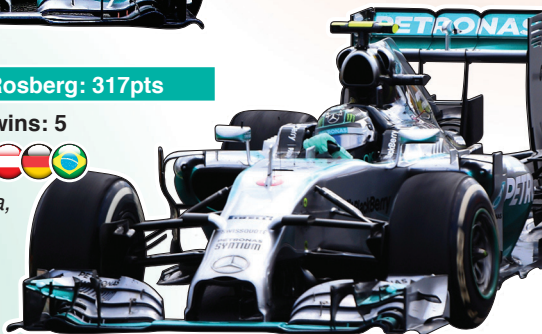

**Hamilton can win title if he...**

- Finishes ahead of Rosberg
- Finishes 2nd and Rosberg wins
- Finishes no lower than 5th if Rosberg is 2nd, or 6th if Rosberg is 3rd, or 8th if Rosberg misses podium, or 9th if Rosberg is 5th

**\*Rosberg can win title if he...**

- Wins race and Hamilton finishes no higher than 3rd
- Finishes second and Hamilton is no higher than 6th
- Finishes no lower than 5th and Hamilton does not score any points
