
Israel-Jordan gas supply deal in jeopardy

A preliminary agreement for Israel to supply up to \$15 billion of natural gas to Jordan could be threatened because of escalating Israeli-Palestinian tensions over Jerusalem's holy sites

Leviathan field: Vast offshore reservoir could supply Jordan with gas from 2017, via planned pipeline to Israeli border near Beit Shean. Deal would end Jordan's reliance on gas from Egypt and cut its annual energy bill by \$1.4bn
