▲ **Apple Computer, founded by Steve Jobs and Steve Wozniak, was incorporated. “Computer” was removed from the name when the iPhone was launched in 2007**

1795: English potter Josiah Wedgwood died aged 64

1990: Deposed Panamanian dictator General Noriega surrendered to U.S. authorities after 10 days under siege

1995: The World Health Organisation reported that AIDS cases worldwide now exceeded one million

2010: Airport security was tightened worldwide after a failed attack in which a man tried to blow up a plane using explosives sewn into his pants
