January 20, 1945

▲ **Franklin D. Roosevelt was sworn in for his fourth term as U.S. president, a record that will go unbroken as there is now a limit of two elected terms**

1320: Wladislaw I was crowned king of Poland. In defeating the Knights of the Teutonic Order, he created strong foundations for one Polish nation

1920: Italian film director **Federico Fellini** was born. His best known films included **La Dolce Vita**

1929: In Old Arizona, the first major Western to use sound, was released

2010: A French court ruled that an Orthodox church built in Nice by Tsar Nicholas II, belonged to Russia
