January 23, 1980

▲ **Israel completed its withdrawal from two-thirds of the Sinai Peninsula, under the terms of the Camp David Accords. All troops were withdrawn by April 1982**

1907: The first Native American senator, Charles Curtis of Kansas, began his term of office

1995: U.S. intelligence reported that Iran paid \$10 million for the Lockerbie bombing, casting doubt on previous assertions that Libya was solely responsible

2005: Veteran U.S. chat-show star Johnny Carson died at age 79

2006: Canada's Conservative Party ended 13 years of Liberal Party rule
