
## **Cold War tankbuster still bringing the pain**

Originally developed in the 1970s to counter Soviet tanks and ground troops, the A-10 Thunderbolt II – better known as the "Warthog" – is among the oldest aircraft in service with the U.S. Air Force

**Durability:** Titanium armour protects pilot and key systems - plane can take significant damage and still fly

Wings: Wide, low-set configuration for superior manoeuvrability at low speed and altitude



up to 1,350 rounds. Variety of other weapons carried on 11 hardpoints



Firepower: A-10's seven-barrel 30mm GAU-8 Avenger rotary cannon can fire up to 70 rounds per second and disable enemy tanks at range of over 6,500m

to give partial shielding from ground fire. Aircraft can fly on one engine
