January 25, 1945

▲ **Grand Rapids, in the U.S. state of Michigan, became the first city to add fluoride, a mineral found in rocks and soil, to its drinking water to reduce tooth decay**

1915: Alexander Graham Bell, in New York, held the first inter-continental telephone conversation with Thomas Watson in San Francisco

1919: A proposal to create the League of Nations was agreed

1975: Sheikh Mujibur Rahman became president of Bangladesh

1990: Pakistani Prime Minister Benazir Bhutto became the first-ever head of government to give birth while still in office
