1500: Spain made landfall in Brazil but was unable to claim it due to a treaty between Spain and Portugal dividing the New World along geographical lines

1790: Mozart's comic opera *Così fan tutte* was first staged in Vienna

1875: U.S. inventor George F. Green of Kalamazoo, Michigan, patented the electric dental drill

1965: Riots broke out in southern India after Hindi was declared the country's official language
