

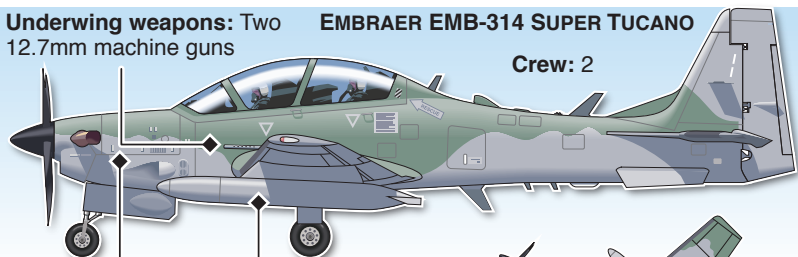
UAE to acquire Brazilian Super Tucanos

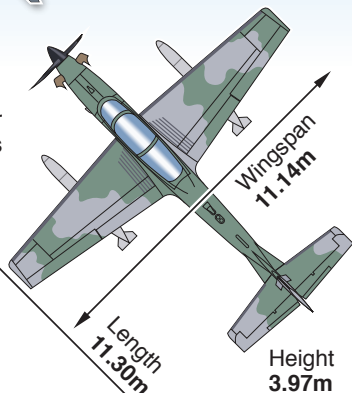

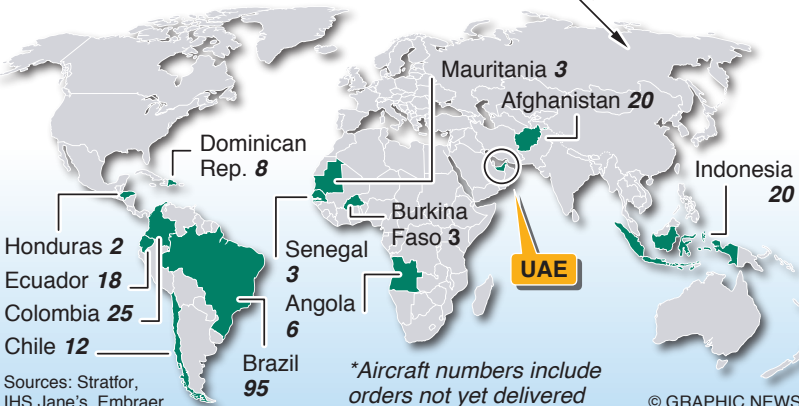
