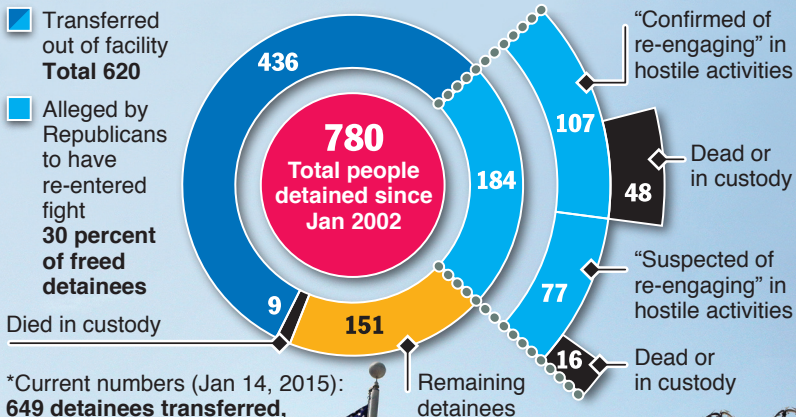


# Dispute over Guantanamo recidivism rate

The Obama administration and Republican senators are waging a war of words over the number of terror suspects who have re-entered the fight after being released from the U.S. detention centre at Guantanamo Bay

## OBAMA ADMINISTRATION

■ Accuses opponents of inflating recidivism rate by combining former detainees "confirmed" of re-engaging in hostile activities with those "suspected"

■ Says more than 90 percent of detainees transferred during Obama administration have not been confirmed or suspected of committing hostile activities after their release

## PROPOSED SENATE LEGISLATION

■ Would bar transfer of detainees to Yemen for two years, suspend transfer of high or medium-risk terror suspects, and repeal law allowing transfer of inmates to foreign countries

■ Bill would also prohibit transfer of terror suspects to foreign countries if individual transferred from Guantanamo was confirmed to have engaged in terrorist activity
