Today in History

February 10, 2005

▲ Influential playwright Arthur Miller, whose works included *Death of a Salesman* and *The Crucible*, died aged 89. He was briefly married to Marilyn Monroe

1955: Thousands of armed police evicted 60,000 blacks from their homes in Sophiatown, near Johannesburg, South Africa, under the apartheid policy

1970: Arab terrorists killed one Israeli and wounded 10 others in an attack on an El Al airliner at Munich

1975: Pakistan's National Awami Party was banned and its leaders arrested

2005: Prince Charles, heir to the British throne, announced he would marry Camilla Parker-Bowles
