44BC: Roman Emperor Julius Caesar was murdered on the Ides of March by senators led by Brutus and Cassius

1922: Sultan Fuad I changed his title to King of Egypt and Sudan when the UK recognized Egyptian independence

1985: Military rule ended in Brazil

2005: Bernard Ebbers, former CEO of WorldCom, was convicted of fraud and conspiracy in the largest accounting scandal in U.S. history
