Four-time champion **Sebastian Vettel's** move to Ferrari precipitated a shake-up, with four drivers switching teams including **Fernando Alonso**, who returns to McLaren eight years after his acrimonious departure. Five fresh faces in the F1 paddock include the Netherlands' **Max Verstappen** – F1's youngest ever driver – and Spain's **Carlos Sainz Jr** at Toro Rosso, Brazilian rookie **Felipe Nasr** at Sauber, while Britain's **Will Stevens** and Spaniard **Roberto Merhi** start for Manor F1
