Report names Islamic State's "Jihadi John"

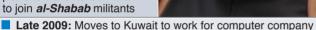
The Islamic State militant known as Jihadi John is reported to have been unmasked as Londoner Mohammed Emwazi, aged 27

- Mohammed Emwazi:
 Kuwaiti-born British man
- believed to be from Queen's Park in West London
- 2009: Graduates in computer sciences from University of Westminster
- University of Westminster

 May 2009: Emwazi
 believed to have been

radicalised after being

deported during visit to Tanzania. Questioned by MI5 – UK's domestic security agency – over suspicions he plans to travel to Somalia to join *al-Shabab* militants



- Jun 2010: Detained again by British security services
- 2012: Travels to Syria, later joining so-called Islamic State
- 2013: Emwazi is identified as part of team guarding Western captives at prison in Idlib, Syria. Nicknamed Jihadi John by some of his hostages

Victims seen in videos featuring Jihadi John 1 Aug 19. 2014: American 5 Nov 16: Former U.S. Army

- 1 Aug 19, 2014: American photojournalist *James Foley*, aged 40, beheaded by IS after U.S. declines to pay \$132 million ransom
- journalist *Steven J. Sotloff*, 31. beheaded
- 3 Sep 13: British aid worker *David Haines*, 44, beheaded
- 4 Oct 3: British aid worker and ambulance driver *Alan Henning*, 47, beheaded
- Ranger and aid worker **Peter Kassig**, 26, beheaded. Detailed examination of video suggests Kassig may have resisted his captors

 6 Jan 20, 2015: Japanese
- 6 Jan 20, 2015: Japanese hostage *Haruna Yukawa*, 42, beheaded. IS demands Jordan release female militant
- **7 Jan 30:** Japanese journalist *Kenji Goto*, 47, beheaded
