
China to boost military budget by 10 percent

CHINA'S PUBLICLY DISCLOSED

- General: Modernising and improving conditions for 2.3 million-strong People's Liberation Armv. Production of advanced weaponry. Greater pay for officers to combat corruption
- Navy: First indigenous aircraft carrier reportedly being built - due to become China's second carrier, entering service around 2020. Expansion of submarine fleet and anti-submarine capability
- Air and space: Development of stealth fighter jets. Money also likely to go into satellites and cyber capabilities
