
Germans baulk at cost of hosting F1

The German Grand Prix could be dropped from the F1 calendar after organisers appeared unwilling to pay the estimated \$22 million fee demanded by the Formula One rights holder for the right to stage a race

HOSTING FEES: Confidential, vary from one venue to another, and rise by up to 10% each year. Only Monaco pays no fee due to its blue riband status.
