
UK to create world's largest marine reserve

Britain says it will establish the world's largest continuous marine reserve – covering an area almost three-and-a-half times bigger than the landmass of the United Kingdom – in the Pacific Ocean



PITCAIRN ISLANDS

- Among most remote island groups in world. Population around 60, mostly descended from sailors who staged mutiny on ship HMS Bounty in 1789
- New reserve aims to protect nearpristine ocean habitat from illegal fishing activities. Waters are home to at least 1,249 species of marine mammals, seabirds and fish
