

- Sep 16, 1923: Born in then British colony of Singapore
- 1942-45: Education at Raffles College interrupted by Japanese occupation of Singapore during World War II
- 1946: Studies law at Cambridge University in England, where he is known as "Harry"
- 1947: Secretly marries fellow student Kwa Geok Choo
- 1950: Returns to Singapore
- 1954: Helps form *People's Action*
- Party (PAP) and becomes party's secretary-general ■ 1955: Wins seat in legislative
- starts law firm Lee & Lee 1959: Becomes Singapore's first prime minister after PAP wins

self-governance in all matters except defence and foreign affairs 1963: Declares full independence

1959: Britain grants Singapore

- from Britain. Singapore unites with Malaya to form Federation of Malaysia
 - 1965: Singapore splits from Malaysia to become independent
 - 1990: Resigns as prime minister but continues to wield influence - after more than 20 years of spectacular economic growth in Singapore
 - 2004: Son Lee Hsein Loong becomes prime minister
 - 2011: Resigns from executive committee of PAP after poor election results
 - Mar 23, 2015: Lee dies six weeks after being hospitalized with severe pneumonia
