Families flee mounting death toll in Yemen

Hundreds of families are fleeing their homes amid mounting civilian casualties in Yemen, where air strikes by a Saudi-led coalition are continuing to target Iranian-backed Shiite Houthi rebels



KEY DEVELOPMENTS

1 Al Mazraq: Dozens of civilians killed and wounded in air strike on camp for displaced families

2 Sanaa: Huge explosions rock Yemeni army weapons facility outside capital. Depot reportedly used to store *Scud* ballistic missiles

3 Aden: Air strikes pounding Houthi advance on last major stronghold of legitimate president *Abdrabbuh Mansur Hadi*. Houthis supported by Yemeni army units loyal to former president *Ali Abdullah Saleh*

4 Saudi Arabia: Ready to deploy 150,000 troops to Yemen border for ground operation against Houthis

FOREIGN NATIONALS IN YEMEN

China: Has evacuated more than 570 of its citizens to Djibouti, to be flown home

India: Sending five ships and four aircraft to evacuate about 4,000 of its nationals, over half of them nurses, trapped by fighting

Pakistan: Has reported safe return of more than 500 out of estimated 3,000 of its citizens residing in Yemen

Egypt: Up to 7,000 workers in Yemen, including 500 married to Yemeni women

Sri Lanka: 120 nationals to be evacuated to Oman
