▲ **The Battle of Tsushima in the Russo-Japanese war resulted in a decisive victory for Japan, the first by an eastern nation over a major European power**

1900: Belgium became the first country to elect a government by proportional representation

1980: Dr Milton Obote, deposed as Uganda's president by Idi Amin in 1971, returned home from exile

1990: Soviet citizens went on a massive buying spree after food prices were scheduled to double

2010: The Gulf of Mexico oil spill was declared the worst oil spill in U.S. history
