▲ **Israel began a full-scale invasion of Lebanon, intended to eliminate Palestinian bases and forces within range of Israel's northern settlements**

1933: The world's first drive-in movie theatre opened in New Jersey

1980: For the second time in a week, U.S. nuclear forces went on red alert following a computer error warning of a Soviet attack

1989: Scenes of hysteria accompanied the funeral of the Ayatollah Khomeini in Tehran, Iran

1994: A drawing for a first edition of a Tintin comic book was auctioned for a record \$100,000 in Paris
