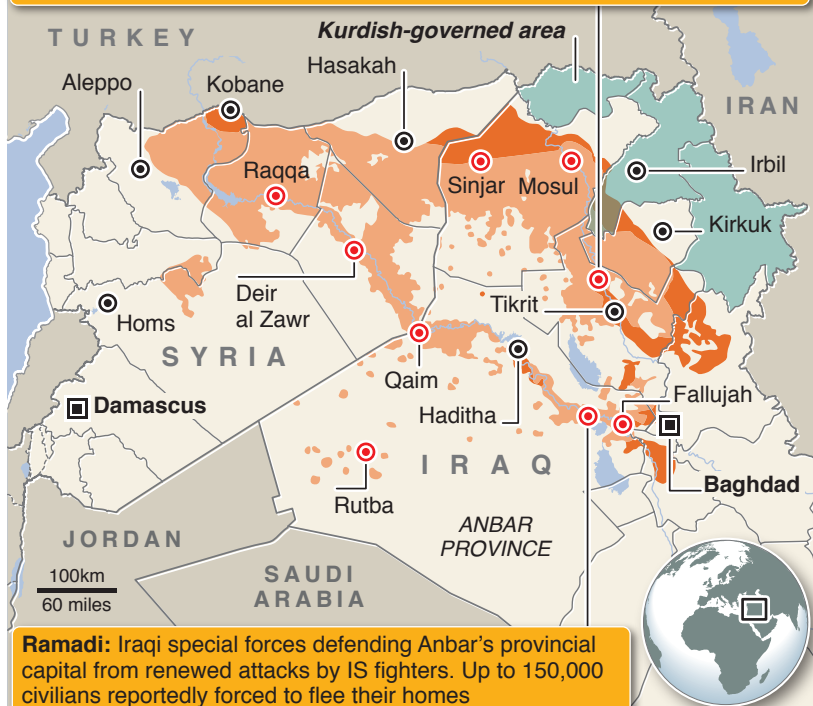


IS militants battling for two big Iraqi prizes

Militants from the so-called Islamic State group are on the offensive again in Iraq, with fierce fighting reported around the provincial capital of Anbar province and the country's largest oil refinery
