1968: James Earl Ray, wanted for the assassination of Martin Luther King, was arrested in London

1995: Police fired 800 rounds of teargas at Vietnamese boat people protesting against their imminent deportation from Hong Kong

1995: Missing American pilot Scott O'Grady was rescued by U.S. Marines in Serb-held territory in Bosnia
