▲ **Felipe VI was crowned King of Spain, challenged with restoring the monarchy's prestige after a series of scandals and amid economic discontent**

1905: The first Nickelodeon, a small theatre converted to show films, opened in the U.S. city of Pittsburgh

1975: Missing British aristocrat Lord Lucan was convicted in his absence of the murder of his children's nanny

2000: The removal of borders between national parks created the world's largest wildlife park in southern Africa

2005: The U.S. Grand Prix ended in farce when all 14 cars using Michelin tyres withdrew for safety reasons
