

Deputy Premier, for many years the public face of Saddam Hussein's regime, has died in an Iragi prison

Tariq Aziz Irag's former

- literature before career in journalism. Edits main Baath Party newspaper 1970s: Named information minister
- 1977: Joins Revolutionary Command Council - senior Baath committee ruling Iraq - becoming
- deputy prime minister in 1979 1980-88: Helps win U.S. support
- for Iraq in its war with Iran 1990: Recognisable figure in world media following invasion of Kuwait
- letter from then U.S. President George Bush to Saddam, signalling inevitability of first Gulf War

1991: Famously refuses to accept

2003: Gives himself up to U.S. forces two weeks after fall of Saddam Oct 2010: Sentenced to death by Iraq's Supreme Court for
