Apple makes big push into music streaming

Tech giant Apple has unveiled its Apple Music streaming service – designed to challenge rivals such as Spotify, Google and Amazon

AVAILABLE: In 100 countries on June 30 for iOS devices (Android in autumn). After free three-month trial, users pay \$9.99 per month, or \$14.99 for families (up to six people)
